AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §139-1 OF THE JEFFERSON MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES

CITY OF JEFFERSON ORDINANCE NO. 8-24

WHEREAS, the City of Jefferson had previously adopted a fire prevention ordinance, set forth in Chapter 139 of its Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, one of the references in Chapter 139 is outdated and needs to be amended.

- **Section 1.** Section 139-1 of the Code of the City of Jefferson is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- **Section 2.** Section 139-1 henceforth shall read as follows:

The most current edition of the National Fire Protection Association Codes and Standards is hereby adopted by reference and made part of Chapter 139.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective on the date after its enactment and publication of this ordinance as required by law.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING EXEMPTION FROM COUNTY LIBRARY TAX

CITY OF JEFFERSON RESOLUTION NO. 59

WHEREAS the Jefferson County Board has established a county library service and levies a county library tax as authorized under Section 43.57 (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS Section 43.64 (2) (b) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that a village or city is exempt from the county library tax if it levies a tax for public library service and appropriates and expends for a library fund as defined by s.43.52 (1) during the year for which the county tax levy is made a sum at least equal to the county library tax rate in the prior year multiplied by the equalized valuation of the property in the city or village for the current year, and

WHEREAS, the city of Jefferson will, in 2025, appropriate and expend an amount in excess of that calculated above,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the city of Jefferson hereby requests of the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors that the city of Jefferson be exempted from the payment of any tax for the support of the County Library Service as provided in Section 43.64 (2).

RESOLUTION APPROVING AERATION BLOWER REPLACEMENT PURCHASE

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Wastewater Treatment Aeration System requires an aeration blower replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Wastewater Utility obtained pricing from Mulcahy Shaw Water for the replacement and upgrade parts in the amount of \$40,207.00; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed the quotes and concurs with the recommendation of the Wastewater Utility Superintendent to purchase the replacement and upgrade parts from Mulcahy Shaw Water and will be funded with Replacement Fund monies and recommends the same to the Common Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Jefferson, Wisconsin that it herein approves the purchase of the aeration blower and upgrade system parts from Mulcahy Shaw Water; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Jefferson that the City Administrator is herein authorized and directed to execute any contract or document associated with the above action on behalf of the City of Jefferson following its review by the City Attorney.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DEVELOPERS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JEFFERSON AND JEFFERSON HILLS CONDOMINIUMS, LLC

CITY OF JEFFERSON RESOLUTION NO. 61

WHEREAS, Jefferson Hills Condominiums, LLC (the Company) intends to acquire a parcel of vacant land located within the legal boundaries of the City of Jefferson. The property is an undeveloped parcel located on the north side of the City and abuts Junction Road; and

WHEREAS, the Company intends to construct multi-use commercial and residential units upon the Property, including approximately fifty-four town house condominiums and two separate retail sites totaling 11,500 square feet. The estimated taxable value of the project at build-out is approximately \$19 million (the Project); and

WHEREAS, the project requires the extension of street and utility infrastructure to serve the development. The extension of public improvements will occur in two phases. The estimated cost of the public infrastructure improvements is \$1,376,515; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes empower cities to assist development projects by lending or contributing funds and performing other actions of a character which the City is authorized to perform for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates providing financial assistance to cover a portion of the public infrastructure improvements to serve the project. Said assistance will not exceed \$880,000 and will be paid by combination of a cash contribution and pay-go tax increment assistance; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Jefferson, Wisconsin that it herein approves and authorizes a Developer's Agreement between the City and Jefferson Hills Condominium, LLC which sets forth the obligations of each as related to the project. The Mayor, Administrator, City Clerk, and City Attorney are authorized to execute documents related to the Developer's Agreement on behalf of the City of Jefferson.
